## **DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS**

1. Introduction to new staff.

The Town has hired two new staff members:

Billy Martinez, long time resident will be helping with vehicle mechanics and maintenance on a part time basis with most of his hours used in winter months with snow plowing.

Lorenzo Sandoval, also a long time resident and past Mayor will be helping with maintenance and also work as Code Compliance. His experience with the Town rules and regulations will be a big asset for the town as well as his determination to make Red Cliff inviting for residents and guests.

2. Update of snow and road conditions.

There has been a lot of snow and weather conditions with lots of overtime expected for maintenance workers. They have been able to keep up with assistance from Eagle County removing excess snow from the snow storage areas. Residents are reminded to keep snow out of the middle of the road, use planned snow retainage areas and any removal that must be made have excess snow placed at the side of the road.

Mayor Gerber noted he has started work on a town project to bring competitive horseshoe pits into Red Cliff.

#### 2. Administrator Update

The Eagle River Community Plan meeting is from 9am – noon on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup>. Lorenzo Sandoval volunteered to attend as town staff.

The Town has a new building inspector from RG & Associates, John Schmacher, who has many years of experience as a building official.

At the last Mayors and Managers meeting in Eagle discussions were about adopting consistent town regulations for drones and for animal codes/requirements. Also a discussion on the county first time home buyer program. The program helps home buyers with down payments to allow them to get into their first homes with a payback system (2<sup>nd</sup> loan) that offsets the initial amount for closing.
