APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion by Duke Gerber to approve the agenda, seconded by Tom Henderson, unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Jake Spears, 179 High Street, noted the passing of long time Red Cliff resident Kate Heriot. The Board and Staff expressed their condolences and willingness to help the family should they want to use any of the Town facilities.

DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS

1. Review and Action on the P&Z Commission suggestions for the Hill addition at 521 Water Street.

Motion by Valarie Blevins to approved the request with the conditions suggested by Planner Scot Hunn:

- a) Applicant shall revise the site plan to clearly show all proposed grading and drainage details (existing and proposed contours, with drainage patterns) for the driveway. Materials (aggregate, asphalt or concrete) for the driveway and parking surfaces is to be shown on the plan.
- b) Applicant shall provide color boards, and/or sample materials describing all exterior materials, as well as specifications (cut sheets) for exterior fixtures, prior to or concurrent with building permit application.
- c) Applicant shall revise and update the plans prior to or concurrent with building permit application to clearly show locations for all exterior light fixtures. Exterior light fixtures are required to be dark sky compliant.
- d) Prior to or concurrent with building permit application, the Applicant shall provide evidence from easement holders and/or utility companies demonstrating that any easements may (or already have been) abandoned, or that placement of a new residential structure on, over, across or within an existing easement is approved and will not impact utility service to the subject property or neighboring properties.

Seconded by Amelia Neat, unanimously approved.

2. TransRockies Run Event, August 16 & 17. TransRockies would like to return to Red Cliff this year as they have for the past 13 years. The format to remain consistent with prior years. Motion by Valarie Blevins to approve the event with the following conditions:

- a) Notify residents who live nearby
- b) May not block sidewalk or the Post Office.
- c) Require better trash pick up
- d) Keep out of the single lane of the road during the event.

Seconded by Art Fox, unanimously approved.
