Mandy Ivanov presented to the Board regarding the passage of HB19-1033 in which Colorado counties are now able to enact tobacco policies to a similar degree as that which is granted to towns and cities. Because of the significant increase in use by youths in our area, Eagle County is considering a county-wide tobacco policy and is asking municipalities do this as well. She presented three potential ways to move forward with this: a licensing program, an increase in the age to purchase to 21, and/or a tax increase.

## 2. Administrator Update

Manager/Clerk Barb Smith reported:

John Volk has located a water leak at the end of Monument Street which is most likely an abandoned tap and the home owner's responsibility. The Code Compliance Officer gave a letter to the homeowner, noting that if the town does the repair work, the homeowner will be responsible for paying for it.

Eagle River Community Water Plan is having a meeting August 12<sup>th</sup>, if anyone wants to go. Regarding the water treatment plant bridge, a couple of companies are working to get us information. It is looking like it will be around \$200,000 or less. She requested that the Board approve to return the grant funds because they don't fit this project. This was so instructed by the Board.

The Building Inspector will be updating our energy code and will come and talk to the Board about options.

There is a grant possibility for land that the town owns for Amelia's bike trail idea. This information was given to Amelia and Melissa.
