DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS

- 1. Selection of the engineering firm and bridge for the WTF bridge replacement.
 - a. We only received one bid, from Marcin Engineering which was opened and reviewed in the Exectutive Session.
 - b. We are working on the getting the deed transferred to the Town.
 - c. We also need to work with Eagle County to sub-divide the area.
- 2. Selection of Engineering Team for the Streetscape Project.
 - a. We started with 7 RFPs. The top 3 all came in for interviews.
 - b. We will need to stretch out the schedule due to surveying and other considerations.
