Scholarship Program Guidelines

The Red Cliff Community Fund (RCCF) Scholarship is dedicated to helping youth of the community of Red Cliff to attend and to succeed in the educational arena.

The *Purpose* of the **Red Cliff Community Scholarship** is to financially assist deserving high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a course of study at either a two-year or four-year educational institution.

For 2021, the Red Cliff Community Fund's Scholarship award ceiling is \$1,000. RCCF will award 1-5 scholarships. **NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution.**

Criteria and eligibility (RCCF Scholarship Fund applicants)

- 1. Applicant must attend an Eagle County High School.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 2.0 grade point average (or a "C" average).
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.
- 5. All applicants must have the ability to complete 15 hours of community service prior to receiving the award.
- 6. Applicant must be a resident of the Town of Red Cliff.

General Instructions

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is April 30, 2021, 4:00 p.m.
- 2. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered. You may also download a copy of the application online at <u>www.townofredcliff.org.</u>
- 3. You will be notified by mail in May regarding the status of your application.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- 2. A recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
- 3. Personal Essay. Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font.
- **4.** In addition to the above items, applicant must also complete at least 15 hours of community service for the Community of Red Cliff. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter.

Deadline for the application is **April 30, 2021, 4:00 p.m.** Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
