## Parking

Parking is the Town's continuing problem. There really is room for all the cars in town if everyone is considerate of others and plays by the rules.

Please do not park on corners, as on-coming cars cannot see around the corner making it dangerous for kids, pets and other vehicles.

Motor vehicles may not be parked on the road, without moving, for more than 72 hours. We may need to tow it away to keep the roads wide enough to be safe and allow for additional vehicles to be parked.

No RV's, OHV's, Snowmobiles, or unlicensed – expired-licensed vehicles may be parked on the streets, alleys, sidewalks or other public property.

We appreciate all of the Town residents help with these notes to keep the roads safe for kids, pets and other drivers. Visibility is important. And we all know what a challenge it can be to find parking on the street for ourselves and guests.
