Snow Plowing

A few reminders regarding parking during our snowy season. We have several town owned areas that are designated "Snow Dump" areas and need to keep those clear of vehicles at all times. It is vital that we keep "No Parking" areas open this time of year to allow for maintenance operations and safe passage of vehicles. Also, we will again be using our "Street Maintenance This Side Tomorrow" signs and kindly ask that you refrain from parking on that side of the street until the snow has been cleared.

Vehicles, parked on the street, must be moved a minimum of every 48 hours and be currently registered.

Please remember, trailers and snowmobiles may not be parked on the street except for active loading and unloading. Do not park on corners and block everyone's view of cross traffic, kids and dogs.



The more we work together on this, the clearer and safer our streets will be for everyone this winter whether walking or driving.
